



## Trading Conditions

1. The Waveform Festival is a planet friendly event with a strong green and ethical policy. We welcome traders who share our beliefs and are fully cooperative in helping us achieve these aims. Traders who have the best environmental and ethical standards will be given priority to the limited space available. For caterers we are looking for a MINIMUM of 80% organic ingredients.
2. Pitch fees are charged according to size of area requested, type of trade and the number of staff passes required. Pitch location is allocated in advance and cannot be changed.
3. An eco bond will be required from all traders prior to arrival. This will be refunded on departure after a positive report that Trading Conditions have been met.
4. Our Environmental Team of Eco Rangers will be making regular visits during the event to check stalls and offer advice on complying with our environmental policy for traders. We will be arranging pre-event deliveries of wholefoods, biodegradable disposables, eco cleaning products etc. There will be an onsite presence and/or daily deliveries of organic fruit and vegetables, milk, eggs, bottled gas, bottled water etc. We will give you the contact details of these suppliers when we send out invoices to successful applicants.
5. All food to be vegetarian unless otherwise arranged in advance.
6. To ensure all disposables comply with our biodegradable and compostable criteria they must be purchased from the specified supplier, as detailed on the suppliers list.
7. To reduce pollution all traders must use biodegradable cleaning products on site.
8. Waste water to be put into containers provided. Traders are responsible for keeping their area tidy including frontage and prep, camping spaces. All rubbish should be placed in the appropriate recycling / composting skips and bags provided.
9. All electricity used on site will be from renewable sources. Power in the main arena will be provided by generators running on biodiesel, the Green Village will be fully solar and wind powered. Requirements must be booked with your application. To comply with health and safety legislation you can not bring your own generators. Solar panels and wind turbines welcomed.
10. All LPG appliances must have a current safety certificate issued by a corgi registered gas fitter.
11. Sub letting any part of the stall is not permitted.
12. All traders must have public liability insurance, risk assessment and health and safety policy for inspection on site.
13. Only goods specified on your application form to be traded. Any changes must be made 2 weeks before the event and if accepted an amended invoice will be issued.
14. Concessions for alcohol, tobacco and ice cream will be allocated. This includes brandy coffee, vodka jellies etc. Any trader bringing these on site without prior authorization from the markets manager will have them confiscated.
15. Not permitted on site, glass, dogs, body piercing equipment and black henna.
16. No sound systems of any description allowed unless arranged and authorised in advance.
17. All traders are required to comply with the local authority's licence conditions and to cooperate with their officials and the agents of the organisers on site.
18. No refunds will be given due to adverse weather conditions or changes to the advertised programmed events.
19. By trading at Waveform you agree to abide by our conditions. Failure to do so could risk you being closed with no refund given.
